

“Caux Retro, Driven by all of us”: Terms and conditions

The Foyer Rural d'Allouville is organising, on 04 and 05 July 2026, a rally for veteran, vintage and classic vehicles which is open to all owners of all such motorcycles, cars, trucks and tractors:

- Saturday: Country run on the minor roads of the Pays de Caux
- Sunday: Static display on the Stade Municipal d'Allouville-Bellefosse
- All participants in the Saturday run must without fail be present on the Sunday.

The spirit of this event is such that there is no competitiveness or official ranking and that friendliness and conviviality shall prevail. Only people having properly submitted an entry form can participate. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry for any fit reason without justification, even on the day of the event. Should there be any Covid-19 restrictions in place, these must be complied with.

Organisation:

Saturday:

There is an entry fee of 5€ per vehicle; this covers a welcome drink at the end of the run, the rally plate and the lunch on the Sunday. It is a requirement that each entry form is accompanied by a completed and signed indemnity form. Participants are required strictly to follow the instructions given by the organising team, including:

- to participate only on the country run to which they are assigned
- to respect the instructions given during the country run by the motorcycle escorts
- to respect any instructions given as to where the vehicle shall be parked
- to respect the traffic and road regulations.

Sunday:

For each vehicle for which the entry form has been accepted, two lunches will be provided. Participants are required to strictly follow the instructions given by the event stewards:

- to go to the designated parking place
- to respect the instructions regarding movement of vehicles within the parc fermé
- to go to at the appropriate lunch area to which they are assigned with their correct lunch tickets, otherwise lunch will not be provided
- not to go out, as a pedestrian, of the parc fermé without wearing the issued badge (failing this the participant will have to pay the required visitor entry fee).

Behaviour and attitude:

The team of organisers is comprised entirely of volunteers; no disagreeable gesture or words towards a team member by a participant will be tolerated – the offender will be immediately excluded from the event.

No departure of a vehicle before 18.00 on the Sunday will be permitted.

Participants are expected to respect members of the public whom they may meet and to give, as far as possible, any requested information and explanations.

No movement of vehicles is authorised within the static display area on the Sunday.

When leaving their parking place on the Sunday, participants are requested not to leave behind any rubbish (rubbish bins will be provided).

Insurance:

It is a condition of entry that participants are covered by indemnity and vehicle insurance. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss to vehicles or their contents or for any personal injury or loss that may occur on the site.

Complaints and/or claims:

This rally is, by definition, such that friendliness prevails; hence no complaints or claims for compensation will be accepted, even in case of non-admittance, cancellation of the country run, of one of the events or of the rally for any reason. Each participant must commit him/herself to respect unconditionally these terms and conditions which are set by the organisers.
